

## Ruschlikon UK Implementation Group – Special Session with LIMOSS and DXC

On Monday 12<sup>th</sup> October, the RUKIG were joined by James Bobbitt (LIMOSS) and Joe Dainty (DXC) who provided an overview of the proposals to retire legacy submission channels to the Bureau.

Speaking on behalf of the programme, which is overseen by the ASC (Associations Service Committee - a cross market committee responsible for BAU operations of the DXC Central Service), it was explained the aim is to build on the previous PbS (Post Bind Submission) work, looking to involve and align with both Ruschlikon and Future @ Lloyd's Middle Back Office workstream. As part of the PbS implementation, a backlog list of key areas of functionality was identified. It is the intent of the ASC to review, agree and implement this key functionality to create a MVP to drive electronic accounting and settlement via the ACORD eBOT/eCOT message standards.

To strengthen the agenda, Lloyd's announced as part of The Future at Lloyd's Blueprint 2 this month, digital processing and data are at the core of their transformation and ACORD standards will be key to delivering this.
